

Thinking of Getting a Dog?

Many people are unaware of the cost and commitment of taking on a pup or adult dog. Here is a brief summary of all your pups healthcare needs in the first year. Don't forget this doesn't include trips to the vet when your pet is sick, cost of boarding when you are away or any of his/her beds, bowls, and food! Not to mention the time and effort needed to train and exercise your pet throughout his/her life.

Vaccinations:

- We vaccinate dogs against Parvo, Leptospirosis, Hepatitis, Influenza and Distemper in one combination vaccine.
- 1st vaccine at 8 weeks old
- 2nd vaccine at 12 weeks old
- Booster injection every year thereafter.
- Dogs can also be vaccinated against Kennel Cough in a separate vaccine up the nose. This is usually only needed if you plan on boarding your dog in kennels while you are away.

Worming:

- Every 2 weeks until 12 weeks old
- Every month until 6 months old
- Every three months thereafter.

Flea treatment:

- Every month until 6 months old
- Repeat routinely depending on what product you use.

Neutering:

- Recommended for males and females around 6 months of age.
- For all the benefits of getting your pet neutered, just ask your vet!

So what will all of this cost?

- Small dog under 10KG: **£180-220**
- Medium dog 10-20KG: **£210-250**
- Large dog 20-40 KG: **£240-280**
